

New York Suffolk County Enforced the Toxic Free Toys Act

The Department of Health and Services of Suffolk County in the US state of New York has recently approved the resolution No. 884-2017 to change the Toxic Free Toys Act.

According to the law, no retailer shall knowingly distribute, sell or offer for sale a children's product containing certain metals above the regulated limits.

Highlights of the amended law are summarized as below:

Restricted Metals	Total Limit (ppm)
Antimony	60
Arsenic	25
Cadmium	75
Lead (Surface Coating)	90
Lead (Substrate)	100
Mercury	60
Cobalt	* Deleted from the law

The revised rule is effective as of November 6, 2017.
