On October 12, 2019, the California governor signed bill AB 44 banning the sale of fur products in the state. California has now become the first state to ban the sale of animal fur products in the U.S.

According to the published law, effective on January 1, 2023, it will be illegal to sell, offer for sale, display for sale, trade, or otherwise distribute for monetary or nonmonetary consideration a fur product in the state. It will be also illegal to manufacture a fur product in the state for sale.

Fur product doesn't include leather, cowhide or sheepskin. Also, used fur product and fur product used for religious purpose are exempt from this rule.
